

Manyara Lakeview Oasis

Just outside

Lake Manyara National Park

Strung out in the shadow of the Rift Valley escarpment, that great fracture in the earth's surface that divides Africa in two, Lake Manyara is one of Tanzania's more unusual parks. Here you'll certainly see the elephants for which the park is famous, and, if you're really lucky, one of the park's equally well-known tree-climbing lions. There's also a lake filled with wading birds, plenty of olive baboons, and dense forests that make you feel that exciting animals could emerge from the trees at any moment. It's a wonderful chance to mark the transition between the lower plains and the Crater Highlands (with Ngorongoro Crater) away to the west.

Accommodation Manyara Lakeview Oasis


Manyara Lakeview Oasis is perched along the 600-meter Rift Valley escarpment, commanding a stunning vantage point over the river basin with sweeping views of Lake Manyara.

The accommodations, including an infinity swimming pool, are strategically placed right at the escarpment's edge, ensuring unrivaled panoramas of Lake Manyara and its surroundings.

The camp is thoughtfully divided into cabins and safari tents, offering guests a diverse range of accommodation

Activity Day 2

Morning & Afternoon

• After breakfast and briefing about your safari schedule, with packed lunch, your safari driver/guide will be ready to embark towards Lake Manyara National Park, searching for diverse wildlife, birdlife and the stunning alkaline lake. Besides the herds of elephants, you can encounter giraffes, zebras, wildebeests, buffalo, hippos, and various antelope species like impalas and waterbucks. Lake shore's the haven for birdwatchers. It hosts over 400 bird species, including pink flamingos, pelicans, storks, and numerous other waterfowl due to the lake's presence. The diverse habitats attract a wide range of avian species. Take your rime to enjoy the stunning landscapes of the this rift valley lake.

Late in the evening you'll be back to your lodge for refreshments, dinner and overnight.



Accommodation **Acacia Central Camp**

You won't find many better national parks in Africa than the Serengeti, which has few rivals when it comes to both the numbers and variety of animals. Track down the annual migration of wildebeest and zebra. Enjoy the vast horizons that are perfect for spotting predators (especially lions, leopards, cheetahs and spotted hyenas) and their prey (buffaloes, impalas and kongoni), as well as elephants and giraffes. If you're really lucky you'll see a hunt, one of the most exhilarating sights anywhere in the wild. And at every turn, revel in its beauty, with flat-topped acacia trees silhouetted against the setting sun, and so many other classic African safari images.

Activity Day 3

 An early morning, after breakfast, with packed lunch you'll be ready to embark towards the iconic Serengeti, enjoying en-route game drives. Upon arrival, settle into your spacious tented camp within the park. Spend the day exploring the vast plains, tracking wildlife, and if in season, witnessing the great wildebeest migration.


After arrival, depending on how you feel you can embark on evening game drive or enjoy African sunset from your camp. Talk to your safari driver/guide son how you would like to finish your day.
