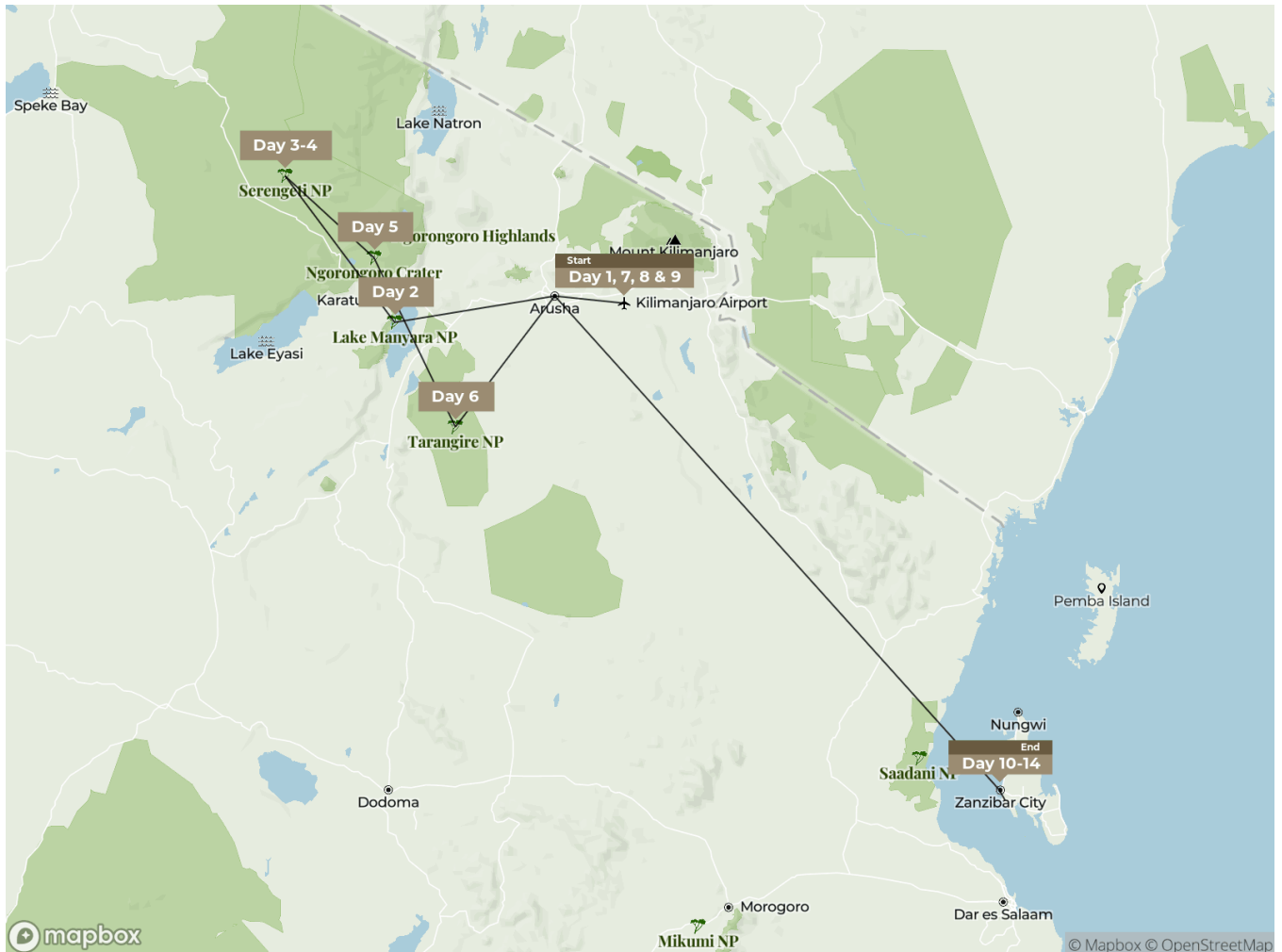

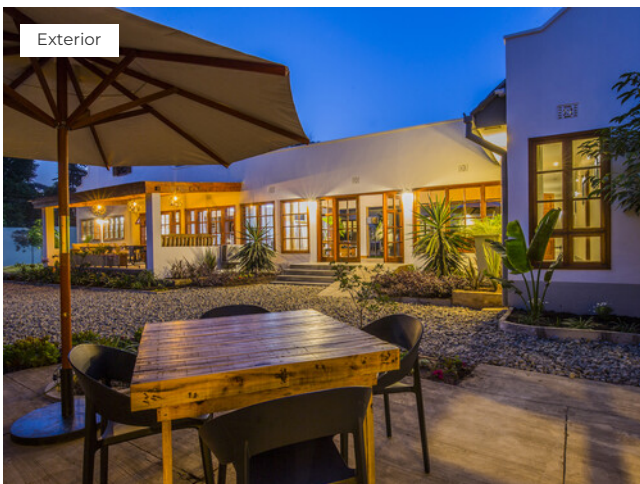
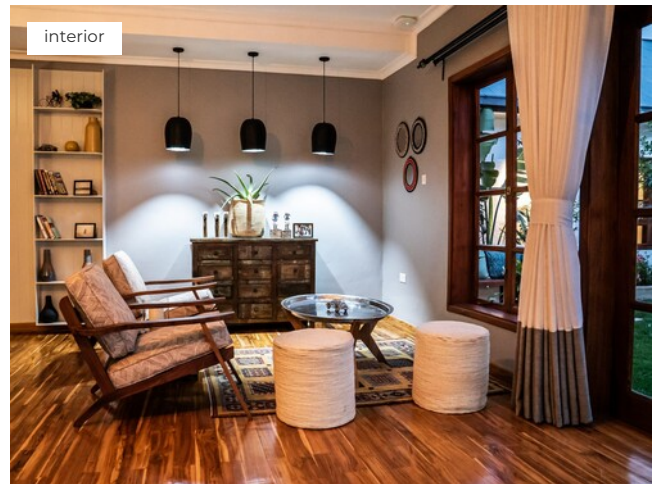


Accommodation | Day 1

Maua Villa

You'll stay with us at Maua Villa. Villa Maua (House of Flowers) could not be more 'central' than its prime location in the safari capital of Northern Tanzania. With just nine, spacious and tastefully decorated garden rooms, this elegant, Cape Dutch inspired, boutique property combines the benefits of being in the 'centre of town' with also being sited in one of the historic residential areas of the city.

Ideal for pre or post safari stays or those visitors with historic or commercial interests in the city, the cosy warmth of Villa Maua creates an ambiance of welcome home-style hospitality complete with a fully stocked licensed bar and restaurant. All rooms are fully air conditioned and equipped with WiFi and satellite televisions.



Lake Manyara National Park

Where the plains of northern Tanzania meet the Rift Valley escarpment, Lake Manyara is a wonderful place to spend a safari day. Your highlights for the day might include getting up-close-and-personal with the elephants that made this park famous, lots of baboons, as well as one of few lion populations in Africa that spend much of their time in the trees. Between the forests at the foot of the escarpment and the lake that gives the park its name, enjoy rich birdlife and the chance of seeing predator ambush their prey.

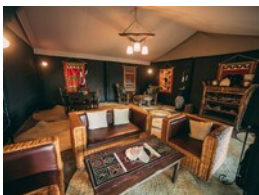
Lake Manyara Tortilis Camp

Inside Lake Manyara National Park

Elephants often wander into camp at Lake Manyara Tortilis Camp. That's because you're staying inside the national park boundaries. If you're really lucky you might hear the park's famous tree-climbing lions roaring at night while you sleep in your safari tent. The birdwatching is also especially good in the area close to camp.

Activities Day 2

Morning

→ Keep an eye out for wildlife this morning as our transfer to the next part of your safari as it doubles your game drive. Enjoy the African landscapes, animals and people along the way as you continue entering the African wilderness. You will arrive on time for refreshments, dinner and overnight.

→ Take a guided game drive around the forests and along the lakeshore of **Lake Manyara National Park**, and look for elephants and tree-climbing lions, all in the company of an expert guide.

Serengeti National Park

Discover just why so many safari visitors fall in love with the Serengeti. Keep an eye out for big cats, even bigger elephants, and almost every kind of safari wildlife you can imagine. You might also see giraffe, impala, zebra, wildebeest, buffalo, hundreds of species of birds, and that may all just be before breakfast. You'll never forget watching these animals interact, whether you see a hunt, a vast herd or a mother protecting her cub or calf. The Serengeti's scenery is also unforgettable – observe Africa's iconic acacia trees, the park's golden grasslands and great piles of boulders known as kopjes.

Activities Day 3

Morning

→ Transfer Game Drive, **Lake Manyara National Park to Serengeti National Park**

A game drive from Lake Manyara to Serengeti National Park offers a unique opportunity to witness some of Tanzania's most iconic wildlife. Keep an eye for animals, African landscapes and people along the way. You will arrive on time for refreshments, dinner and overnight.

Afternoon

→ This afternoon you'll go on a guided game drive through **Serengeti National Park** if you are still fit to do so. Your guide will help you find so many different animals as you drive around the savannah grassland plains of the **Serengeti**. Talk with your safari driver / guide on how you would like to spend the rest of the day.



Accommodation | Day 3 & 4

Kirimu Camp

Stay at Kirimu Camp with us. It's an excellent place to stay as you enjoy this leg of your trip. Kirimu camp is set in the remote setting in the Serengeti plains to offer the exclusive and the 'Out of Africa' experience to our esteemed guests. Each tent is spacious and designed to provide all amenities of a luxury home away from home.

Activity Day 4

All Day

→ After breakfast, you'll be joining us in **Serengeti National Park** for a guided game drive. It's a fantastic opportunity to see some of the animals. Morning game drive is the best time to spot animals along the water holes while predators are waiting for an easy meal. On this this, you may opt to make morning game drive and come back to your camp for a rest and resume in the afternoon. Talk to your safari driver/guide on how you would like to spend the rest of the day. Later, you will be back to your camp for refreshments, dinner and overnight.

Ngorongoro Crater

You'll learn why magical Ngorongoro is unlike anywhere else in Africa. Cloud forests encircle the crater rim, and the view out across the caldera of this former volcano – quite apart from the altitude – will leave you gasping for air. Your drive down a steep trail carries you onto the crater floor where a unique wildlife offering is added to the sheer beauty of the experience. You'll share the sunken ecosystem of the crater floor with hyenas, lions, elephants, black rhinos and hippos. An ecosystem that has formed in the crater in the millennia since the volcano wrought its terrible fury upon the land. It could just be one of your best safari days ever.

Learn about Maasai culture when you spend time with us in a Maasai village.

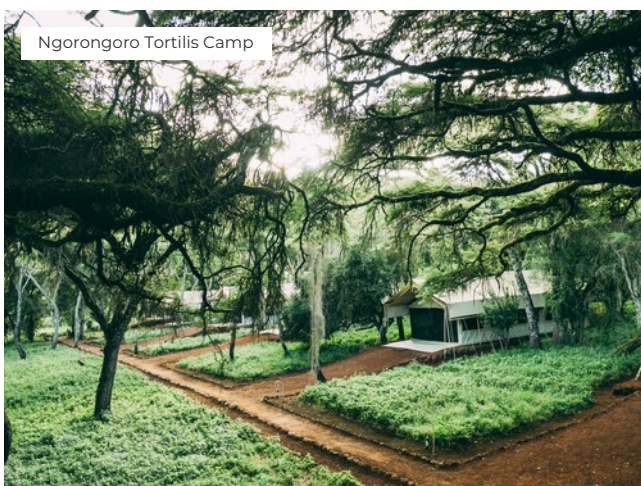


Accommodation | Day 5

Ngorongoro Tortilis Camp

Just outside Ngorongoro Crater

You're not far from Ngorongoro Crater but in the heart of Maasai land when you stay at Ngorongoro Tortilis Camp. The Maasai are a real focus of camp life and activities, and the safari tents beneath the trees are simply beautiful with comfort and style in equal measure. → Transfer Game Drive, **Serengeti National Park** via **Maasai Village** to **Ngorongoro Crater**

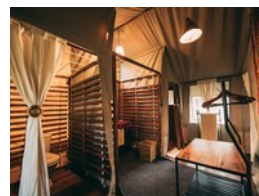

If you've never been to Tarangire (and even if you have) you're in for a real treat. Tarangire is filled with giants – baobab trees all across the park, as well as elephants, lots of them. But that's just the beginning. Of the big cats, you'll probably see lions, and cheetahs and leopards are around, too. And it's impossible to miss the wildebeest, giraffes, hippos, buffaloes and zebras. Your backdrop for all of this is one of the prettiest in northern Tanzania, with a memorable mix of river woodland, open plains and rolling hills. And some vantage points to take it all in.



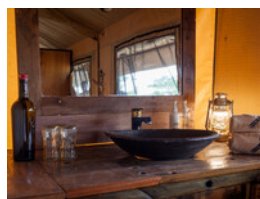
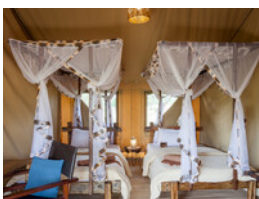
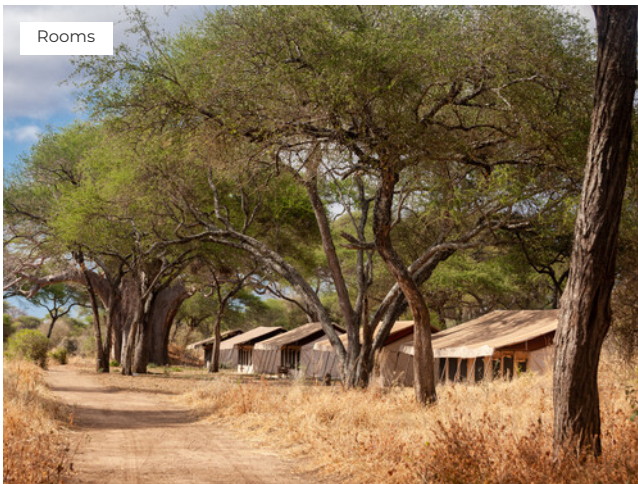
Accommodation | Day 6

Morning

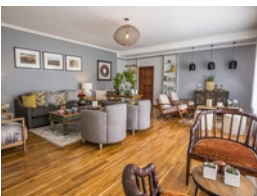
→ Transfer Game Drive, **Tarangire National Park** to **Arusha**. You will arrive safely in Arusha City for refreshments, dinner and overnight.
