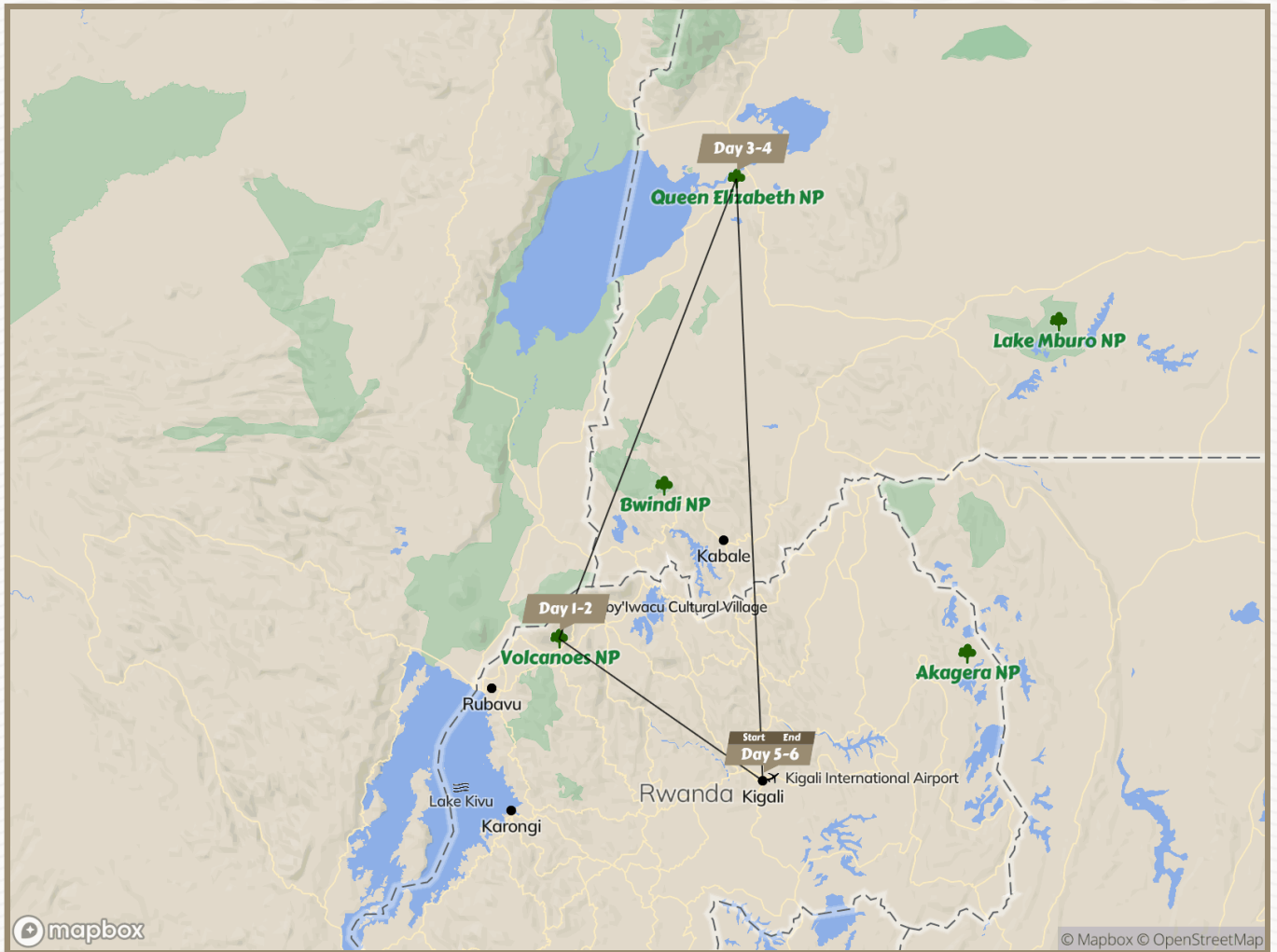

Volcanoes National Park is one of Africa's most iconic wildlife destinations. Nestled in the Virunga Mountains, it is home to around half of the world's remaining mountain gorillas. The park offers visitors an intimate encounter with these magnificent creatures in their natural habitat. The dense, mist-covered rainforest is a lush sanctuary, teeming with life, and provides breathtaking hiking trails and a rich cultural backdrop.

Activities Day 1

Morning

- **Arrival in Kigali:**
Upon your arrival at Kigali International Airport, our team will greet you with a warm welcome. After a quick safari briefing, you'll head out to explore Kigali, one of Africa's cleanest and most vibrant cities.
Transfer time; about 15 min
- **Kigali City Tour:**
Explore the rich history of Rwanda through a visit to the Kigali Genocide Memorial, a poignant reminder of the country's past. Dive into the bustling local markets and stop at the Nyamirambo Women's Center, where you can witness the local artisans at work.

- **Transfer by Road, Kigali to Ingagi Park View Lodge**

Morning

- Early in the morning, after a briefing from the park rangers, you'll begin your trek to find the mountain gorillas. This challenging but rewarding hike leads through mist-covered forests, where you'll spend a magical hour in the presence of a gorilla family.

Queen Elizabeth National Park is Uganda's most visited national park, known for its remarkable biodiversity. It offers a variety of landscapes, from open savannahs to wetlands and tropical forests. The park is famous for its tree-climbing lions, abundant bird species, and the Kazinga Channel, which is home to one of the largest concentrations of hippos in Africa. The backdrop of the Rwenzori Mountains adds a dramatic contrast to the diverse wildlife on display.

Evening

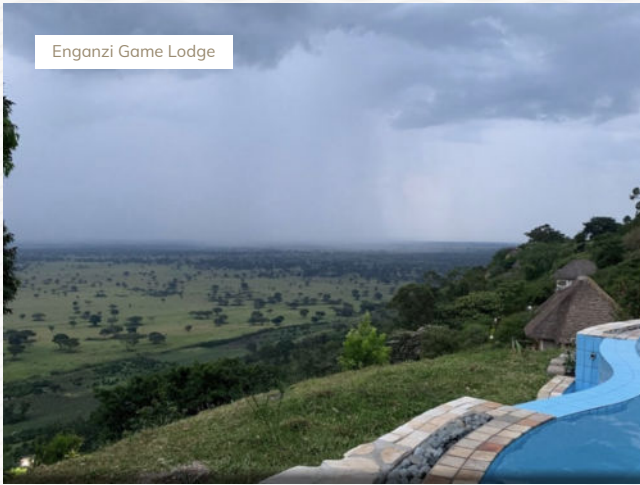

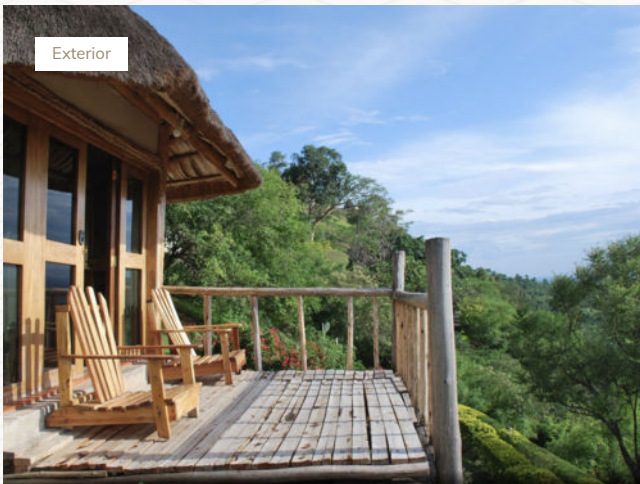

Activities **Day 4**

Morning

- In the morning, embark on a trek in the Kyambura Gorge, also known as the “Valley of Apes,” to observe chimpanzees. This deep gorge is a striking contrast to the flat plains and offers a rich habitat for primates and birdlife.

Afternoon

- In the afternoon we take on a scenic boat cruise along the Kazinga Channel, a 33km long natural and pre-historic canal that joins Lakes Edward and Lake George. Formed by tectonic activity millions of years ago during the formation of the rift valleys, the canal, 2 to 3kms at its widest, is now the most dominant feature of Queen Elizabeth National Park and one her key tourist attractions.
